Oral Demonstration - Instructions

You will be given about 10 minutes to demonstrate the assigned stage of your lesson plan, and about 5 minutes to answer questions from the TPhYL examiner. Your demonstration will be recorded.

Include the following in your demonstration:

1. Demonstrate the activity(ies) you have planned for your assigned stage as you would conduct them in a real classroom situation by showing the following:
 - explicit procedures and instructions to the YLs;
 - interactions with your YLs using verbal and non-verbal teaching techniques; and/or
 - any other suitable teaching techniques and/or qualities.
2. During the demonstration, show how you have used one or more of the following materials indicated in the 'Resource Guidelines' to create or adapt a teaching resource:
 - Brown paper bags
 - Pipe cleaners
 - A4 coloured paper cards
3. The examiner will ask you to give explanations on the following:
 - assessment(s);
 - resource(s); and/or
 - teaching techniques.
